1. I nominate CWO (Ret) Dallas W. Palmer and CWO Gerald D. Husky to join the ranks of our Distinguished Members.
2. The activities of Mr. Palmer in his capacity as full-time assistant Secretary of the Association is well known. He consistently exceeds the requirements of his job by performing services to and for the membership that would otherwise be delayed, dropped, or forgotten. While it may be difficult to draw a line as to where his job stops and his devotion to the Association starts, those of us that know him can not deny that he has done, and continues to do, more than his job requires. This extra devotion should be officially recognized by bestowing the title of Distinguished Member upon him.

The recent activities by Mr. Husky on behalf of the Association in obtaining an insurance plan has added an important benefit for not only our membership, but ~~more~~^{most} military personnel in the Coast Guard as well -- both active and retired.
