
CWO TOLLESON served as National President in 1982 and has served as National Chairman. He is Past President of the WASHINGTON, D. C. CLUB.

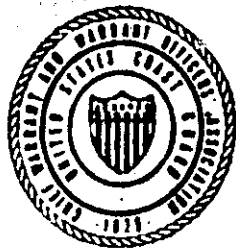
CWO TOLLESON has been very active in The Association since his original appointment to warrant grade.

CWO4 (PERS) David C. OROLFO, USCG is hereby placed in nomination for DISTINGUISHED MEMBERSHIP in The Association.


CWO OROLFO is a Charter Member of the WASHINGTON, D. C. CLUB and remains very active.
