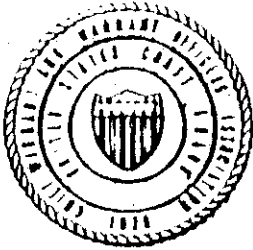
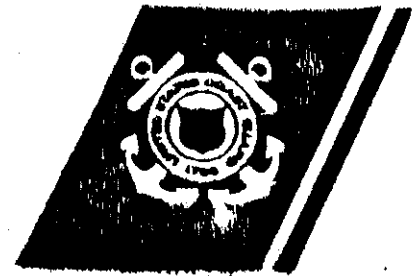

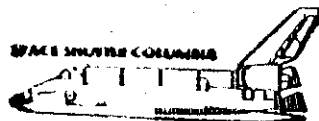
Since appointment to warrant officer CW04 LIEDKE has consistently promoted The Association and it's goals. Some of his accomplishments are:

He did this in such an exceptional manner that for several years thereafter this affair was held in the same manner and eagerly anticipated by the members, those from out of town travelling at their own expense as well as members in visiting ships and those stationed in the local area. Until this affair was moved from the YARD the question was not "Will we have a good turnout?", but "How will we seat them all?".

He served as National President in 1971-1972. During that period he displayed outstanding professional ability and leadership in guiding The Association, rendering an inestimable assistance to the local clubs and the membership as a whole, while representing The Association at the many official functions.

During his long tenure as a member of The National Council he cheerfully volunteered to serve on or chair numerous committees. His many hours of service, much of it drudgery carefully avoided by others, would alone make him a suitable candidate for DISTINGUISHED MEMBERSHIP.

In 1979 on relocation to Florida he became the driving force in establishment of a club of The Association. At the time there were only five known members in the area. Through his initiative others were found and he followed through in the many details necessary in forming a club. On 12 August 1980 The Space Coast Club was chartered with 23 members. There are now 43 regular members. CW04 LIEDKE served as Charter President and is now serving as vice president. During periods when not holding office he demonstrates his continuing interest by constant work in organizing many of the numerous functions conducted by this very active club. His current project is a joint meeting of the four Florida clubs.




CWO4 LIEDKE's professionalism, leadership, and untiring devotion to The Association

MEMBER.


